- 3. Usage First Take Video reserves the right to use videos for display, publication or other purposes. All video masters and raw footage remain the exclusive property of First Take Video. First Take Video must be notified within 3 days after you receive your final delivery of your Blu-ray/DVD if you wish to purchase your raw footage. Raw footage costs \$100.00. After 3 business days of delivery of your DVD or Blu-ray all raw footage is erased and is unrecoverable.
- 4. Postponement/Cancellation In the event of a postponement or cancellation of the affair/contract, The Reservation fee is not refundable.
- 5.
